BZA Case #19984

2908 N St SE

Ms. Moton submitted a permit application to the DC Department of Parks and Recreation seeking permission for outdoor amplified sound on Saturday July 13, 2019 from 10:00 am - 4:00 pm. Commissioner Johnson wrote a letter in support of her permit application. Commissioner Brown moved that the ANC approve the letter that Commissioner Johnson wrote in support of the permit application. The motion passed.
