WHEREAS, ANC Commissioners are trusted and respected advocates for the Naylor - Dupont Communities.

WHEREAS, an ANC Commissioners must be a qualified elector of the single member district in which they reside as outlined in DC Code 1-309.5 Advisory Neighborhood Commission, in short for a minimum of 60 days ; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Elections certifies person to be eligible to be candidate to run for public office.

WHEREAS, the election of the ANC Commissioner for 7B04 has been challenged to the Board of Election on the grounds of residency by Mr. Phillip Hammond; and

WHEREAS, the ANC Commissioner for ANC 7B04 has provided to the Board of Election documents to certify her residency on January 5, 2019;

WHEREAS, the Board of Election determined in a letter signed by the Registrar of Voters dated January 18, 2019 states "the law clearly states, a challenge based upon a change of residence is impermissible. For the foregoing reasons, Mr. Hammond's challenge to your voter registration has failed."

WHEREAS, the Board of Election strongly urged ANC Commission 7B to conduct a special meeting/hearing to determine whether or not a vacancy exist in single member district 7B04.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 7B finds no vacancy in Single Member District 7B04.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED

ANC 7B supports this resolution as it was voted on at its Special Meeting held on April 4, 2019, which was properly noticed and which a quorum was present, by a vote of 6 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstaining.


