Police Report

PSA 603 violent crime is up by 70% and property crime up by 37 %, PSA 605 violent crime down 14% and property crime is down 16%, PSA 606 violent crime is up as well as property crime, and PSA 607 violent crime is up 38 % and property crime is

down 24%. The bones found behind 30th street SE was ruled a suicide. The Sixth District is losing 10 Officer in May.
